COMMUTER HOUSING POLICY

- 1) Housing will be in the form of double occupancy of a one-bedroom apartment in Andrews Hall.
- 2) Furniture provided will include; a bed, dresser, desk, chair, and lamp.
- 3) Microwaves, disposable cutlery and dishware are provided.
- 4) Rooms are not air conditioned. Fans are provided for the June term.
- 5) Linens and towels are provided. Students will have access to laundry machines in Andrews Hall basement.
- 6) No cleaning service will be provided and students must remove their own trash to the dumpster.
- 7) Brooms with dustpans are provided in each apartment, and cleaning supplies are located in dormitory basement.
- 8) Items may be stored for the length of the stay, up to one semester. All personal items must be removed at the end of the stay.
- 9) Cost for spring and fall terms will be \$1200 per semester.
- 10) Cost for January & June terms will be \$175 per week.
- 11) The school will not be responsible for roommate assignments.
- 12) As room availability is limited; assignments will be on a first come, first serve basis. A dated request must be made in writing or via e-mail to the Housing Office including roommate information. **Deadline for the January D.Min. term is November 30th, 2009.** Please include your expected time of arrival on campus.
- 13) The school retains the right to assign a compatible roommate, if an apartment, for whatever reason, currently only has one student residing in it.
- 14) There will be a signed lease/agreement for the length of stay.
